

Sponsorship

For me to achieve what I intend to in 2016 I will need the help of sponsors and advertisers throughout the forthcoming season. Our primary goal is to enable anyone or company to be involved in my journey to success.

When approaching sponsors they often question "What's in it for me and my company?" which is understandable because they are committing to a big deal/contract but we have always replied in the same way because we believe if you help us we try and return the good deed. Therefore we will always try our best to promote your company in the best way possible by both word of mouth and advertising on paddock wear and our race bike because to me the feeling of support from sponsors helps me keep committed and determined to serve them well because they enable me to live my dream and hopefully progress through my career.

So to be clear you will gain severe advertisement on our paddock appeal and also on the race bike which will be seen by the general public due to the backing from Motors TV which televise all of my RRV 450 races throughout 2016. You will also receive race reports from all of my races so you can track my progress and feel part of the ever growing racing experience. We will also try and provide you with free tickets to my events, if possible, so you can gain an insight into what we are about.

Below is listed some of the costs of items that are needed to race in 2016. These are running costs and don't cover the total cost of my racing in 2016.

We would be grateful for any contribution, whether it's big or small, please contact us now regarding sponsorship for 2016.

- Set of tyres= £199 for a dry set and £199 for a wet set. 2016 has a total of £1791 in dry tyres as we need a set per round. However wet tyre total is uncontrollable because it all depends on when they wear out, usually 4 sets a year therefore total= £796
- Fuel for the race bike is often £50 a race weekend, therefore an average of £450 for the year.
- Thundersport GB race entry fees= £2205 on average (different tracks have different entry fees but on average its £254 per round).
- Oil filters= £9, making year fee for oil filters £81.
- Brake pads= £108 for 2 sets for the front (EBC GPFAX Pads).
- Engine refresh= **£1000** depending on spares.
- Engine oil= £105 for a year.
- Gearbox oil= £70 per year.
- Crash damage=??? Unknown hopefully none but help may be needed.

The bold figures above hopefully give you some ideas of what you can sponsor me. However I understand the capability of this process so please don't hesitate to get into contact so we can discuss a deal in further detail accommodating your needs.
